### Meet filmmaker David Pearl

*PolyCultures: Food Where We Live* portrays the diverse communities in post-industrial Cleveland coming together to grow a more sustainable and equitable food system. *PolyCultures* offers the global perspective of national experts (Michael Pollan, David Orr), but it's firmly rooted in the idea that local food is good for the health of individuals, communities, local economies, and the environment.

The term *polyculture* refers to the ecologically-minded technique of growing a diversity of crops and/or animals on one farm, and it also alludes to people coming from very different backgrounds, arriving at similar conclusions, and taking coordinated action.
